We enjoyed yet another Soup & Puddings event with friends of Longford Baptist Church raising £150 over lunch well done everyone food was delicious!!!

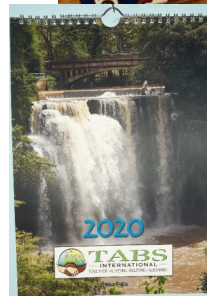
