School registered with Ministry of Education!

The school was fully registered with Kenya's Ministry of Education on 13th July 2021. This is a fantastic achievement and has taken a period of 3 years continual effort.



The benefits to the school and local community are numerous, and we have had to take many steps to get there, including **1)** officially registering the project and school as Community Based Organization; **2)** successfully passing a Public Health Sanitation Inspection and National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) audit Report, and **3)** pass an Educational Quality assurance inspection with Local administrative acknowledgement.

The school will benefit significantly from this achievement in a number of ways. We will be able to set up as an examination Centre - which will enable our children to undertake their national examination (KCPE) within the school, rather than the project / parents paying fees to sit exams at another school. We will be recognized by the Ministry of Education as a legally operating learning institution offering basic education in Kiandutu slums.

We will qualify to be a member of Kenya Private School Association (KEPSA) - enabling our learners to participate in co-curricular activities, and we will become NEMIS compliant – a National Education Management Information System in Kenya, which ensures every learner counts.

Improved academic performance – the institution has recorded an increased performance, as indicated by previous KCPE results for the past 3 years. Follow up shows that 90% of our learners have transitioned to secondary education some getting scholarships i.e. one of our 2020 candidates - John is currently under Elimu scholarship program in Ndururumo High school!

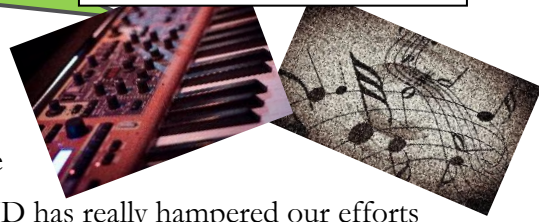
